



## Abstract

In this evening unit, children are introduced to the Centre's weather station and instructed in taking readings. A rota of recorders for the rest of the week is established.

## Learning Objectives:

- To gain experience and an understanding of how we measure key weather components

## Learning Outcomes:

- To monitor weather conditions for the duration of the stay
- To improve weather observation skills
- To measure and record air temperature, maximum and minimum temperature, rainfall, wind direction, wind strength, cloud cover, cloud type and humidity on a twice daily basis using the appropriate equipment

## Options:

- To analyse weather patterns through the construction of graphs and/or a comparison to average conditions (**evening**)
