

Vacancy: Evening Cook / Chef

The Job

An exciting opportunity has arisen for an Evening Cook / Chef to join our friendly catering team in this reputable Outdoor Education

Centre. Responsible to the Catering Manager, the Evening Cook will ideally have experience in a commercial kitchen and would be responsible for producing three course meals for up to 75 students and their teachers. Uniform and full training will be provided. The Centre is very busy this summer and regular work is available during the week and on weekends. You would share the role with another Evening Cook and would need to work around 3-4 shifts per week with more available if you wish.

Shifts tend to start around midday and finish at 7pm (there are no late shifts). During our closed periods (mid-December-late January, and August) there is less work available, however holiday pay is paid during the winter closedown period to help maintain a regularity in income. Organised staff socials in December and July also provide some additional hours of work, as well as being enjoyable events for the entire team.

Hours of Work & Pay

Most shifts begin around midday and finish by 7pm. Evening meals are served from 6pm-7:15pm. Hourly rates are £12/hr, increasing to 13/hr on Sundays. It is a part-time, permanent role.

Person Specification

Full training will be provided, however previous cooking experience would be an advantage. Familiarity with food allergies / intolerances would also be desirable. It is essential that candidates are reliable and can work well as part of a team. Due to the lack of public transport to our village, candidates must all have their own transport.
